

Coonabarabran As It Was In The Beginning

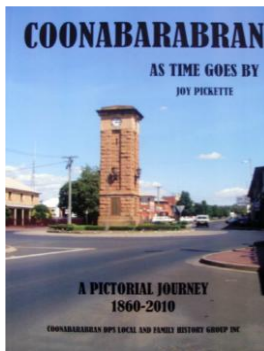

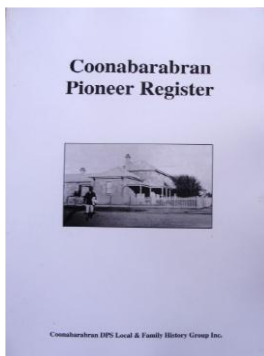
Coonabarabran As Time Goes By

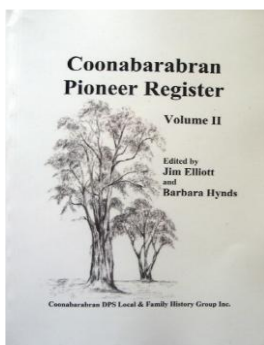


Coonabarabran Pioneer Register (Volume I)

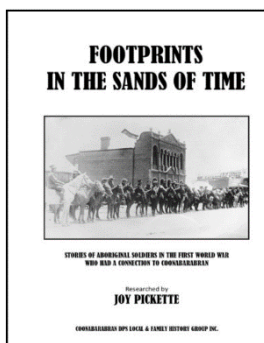
Coonabarabran Pioneer Register Volume II

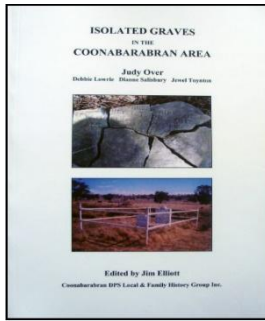
Footprints in the Sands of Time

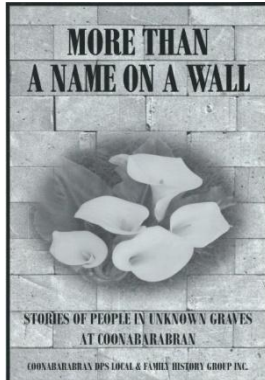


Isolated Graves in the Coonabarabran Area

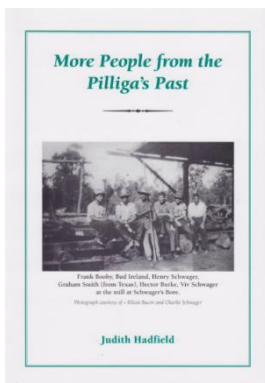
More than a Name on a Wall

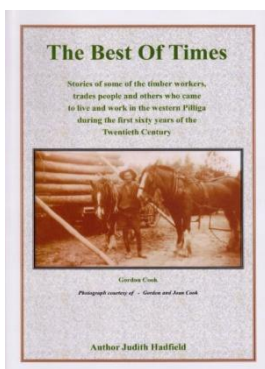
More People from the Pilliga's Past
